### **Reports**

Please find enclosed a copy of your daughter's report from Strathearn. As you will see, this Short Report gives an indication of the level of Effort and Attainment reached in each subject and an additional comment is given by the teacher if deemed necessary. A Full Report with marks and a teacher comment for each subject will be issued after the summer examinations in June.

There will also be a Form 2 parents' consultation afternoon from 3.00 pm to 5.00 pm on Thursday 24 March 2011. At this time you will have the opportunity to discuss your daughter's progress with her subject teachers.

### **School Inspection**

You will have recently received a copy of the report of the Inspection by the Department of Education. We are delighted that the Inspectorate endorsed the many strengths of the school including the very good levels of achievement and the excellent opportunities the pupils have to engage in a wide range of extra-curricular activities. The team commented most warmly on the welcoming atmosphere within the school and on how well they were received by staff and pupils alike. They particularly noted the high levels of motivation and engagement of the pupils towards the school and their learning. I hope in reading the report you will take pleasure from all that we offer and achieve in Strathearn.

### **New Build**

Seven contractors have been short-listed to tender for the work with an estimated cost of £17 millions. That process is on-going and we now have a start date of early March. We continue to be excited at the prospect and are preparing for the necessary alterations to routine for when the work starts. Further details will follow in the new year.

### **Parents' Association**

The Parents' Association have again much planned for the coming year and thank you to all who support their great work and who have contributed to their funds. Their dedication and your co-operation led to a cheque for an outstanding sum of £10,000 being given into Strathearn School funds.

This is an amazing sum and one achieved in the context of financial constraints so this makes us doubly delighted. With this money we will be able to purchase portable lighting equipment for Drama as we lose the stage in the Assembly Hall and also equip further classrooms with digital projectors. This equipment will greatly enhance the provision for the girls and please do continue to help the school by supporting the Parents' Association.
