Dear Parents

Reports

Your daughter will receive two reports this academic year. The first in March will be a Short Report which gives an indication of the level of Effort and Attainment reached in each subject with an additional comment given by the teacher if deemed necessary. A Full Report with marks and a teacher comment for each subject will be issued after the summer examinations in June. There will also be a Form 4 parents' consultation afternoon from 1.50 pm to 4.00 pm on Tuesday 16 June 2009 at which time you will have the opportunity to discuss your daughter's progress with her subject teachers.

Recently Form tutors have been reviewing the progress of all the pupils in their Form class. Head of Key Stage 4, Miss J Gibson, will be in contact with parents of a small number of pupils about whose progress to date we have some concerns. Pupils will also be engaged in a process of self evaluation of their own progress over this first term. If you have any concerns please do contact your daughter's Form tutor through reception in the normal way.

The Department of Education has asked us to distribute a leaflet entitled '*The Revised Curriculum – How we will assess your child and report to you*' which gives some information about possible future developments. A copy should accompany this letter.
