

Strathearn School Contract

McLaughlin & Harvey are delighted to have been awarded the contract for the Strathearn School project. The contract was officially signed on the 14th March 2011. We have had our initial meeting with the school and their design team and will be developing the overall programme for the works over the coming weeks. This is the first of our project Newsletters and further Newsletters will be issued as work progresses.

What will the new school look like?



The development for 770 pupils will include a 10,100m² new school and a 1,600m² refurbishment involving demolition of some of the remaining buildings on the existing campus. Site works will include the provision of new roads and car parking, a synthetic pitch, 2 all-weather hockey pitches and tennis courts. It is planned that the pitches will be finished for November 2011 and the first phase of 32 classrooms ready for occupation in September 2012.

Community / Environmental Issues

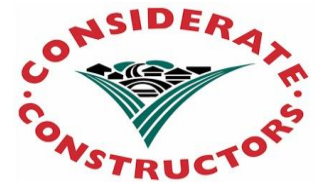
