On Your First Day

The first day of school is Thursday 26th August 2021

- * Go straight to Manning Hall for your first assembly. There will be senior pupils present at Reception to guide you.
- * Your Form Tutor will take you to your Form Room after your first assembly.
- * There will be a morning BREAK so remember to bring a snack to eat, if you wish.
- * On the first day school ends at 12.45 and you are free to go home at this time.
- * Lunch will not be available in school on the first day.

Lost Property

On Your Second Day

Using a mobile phone

Now that you are in Form 1, you may have been allowed to have your own mobile phone.

Your mobile phone is a very useful device and whoever has bought it for you has done so to help keep you safe!

However, to make sure you use it correctly we have some 'golden' rules for using mobile phones in school.



You can check your messages before school, at break and at lunchtime. At all other times your phone should be switched off. When you are eating your lunch, don't use your phone - it is not a good way to make friends if you are looking at a screen! It's much better to chat to those around you.

Travelling home

If you plan to get a bus from school, these services start from Wednesday 1st September.

It is a good idea to practice your route home during the summer holidays, but, don't worry - there will be staff and pupils available to help you get on the right bus at the start of term.

School Planner and Timeable

Your form tutor will give these out and explain them to you on your first day. The School Planner will give you more information about school routines and procedures.

PE

For your first PE lesson, you should bring your normal hockey kit. You will **not** need your stick.



Lockers

- You will be given a locker of your own where you can leave your coat and keep your books.
- 2. You must keep your locker in good order.
- 3. You will be taken to see your locker and you will have to make up a special 4 digit code — you will have to remember this number!
- **4.** Remember to keep your locker locked at all times.
- 5. When you come to school in the morning go to your locker, leave your coat and collect your books for Periods, 1, 2 and 3.

- **6.** At break time go to your locker and collect your books for Periods 4, 5 and 6.
- **7.** At lunch time collect your books for Periods 7, 8 and 9.
- **8.** Before going home, fetch your coat and get any books you might need for homeworks.
- Do not leave any belongings outside or on top of your locker at any time.
- 10. Your PE equipment may be kept in the cubby-holes beside the lockers. Everything should be labelled and is left at your own risk.



Lunch Time

Lunch time begins at 12.50pm

- * For the first week you will have lunch in the canteen at 12.45pm. You may have canteen lunch or bring a packed lunch if you prefer.
- * You may leave your bags in the allocated rooms while you eat lunch, but do not leave any valuables!
- * You may use the common rooms after you have had your lunch.

- * During your lunch break you should go to your locker to collect books for periods 7-9.
- * A bell will ring at 1.40pm when you should go to class. **Period 7 begins promptly at 1.45pm.**
